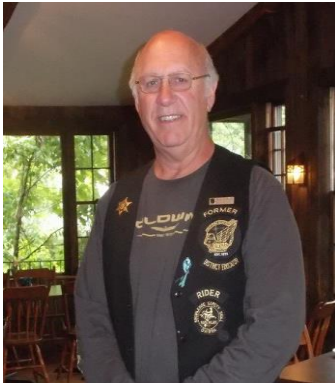

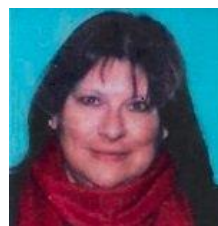

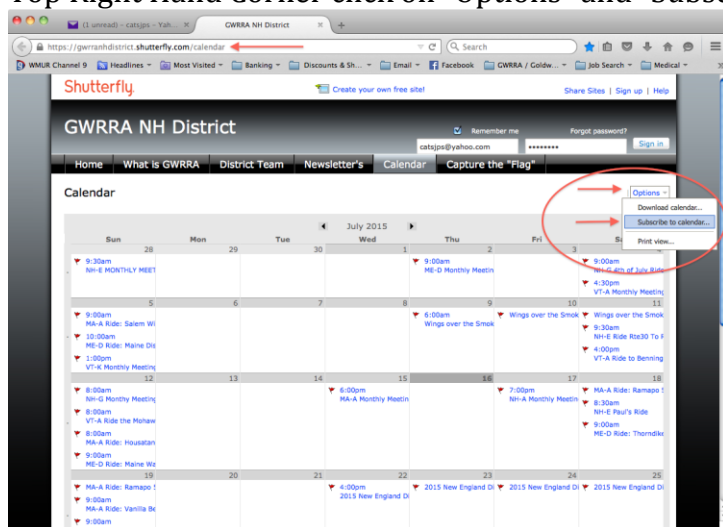
You might ask WHY do we need a consolidated ride schedule?

The consolidated schedule allows you see all the planned rides across our district/region so you can do just that. PLUS by attending other chapter's rides you will experience some great rides, strengthen the relationships between the regional chapters, make new friends, explore new regions, and have fun.

Anyone can go to the link and see the schedule but **if you "Subscribe" to the calendar you will automatically receive email reminders for upcoming rides and events as well and any updates, date changes or cancellations to existing rides.**

To Subscribe:

1. Go To <https://gwrranhdistrict.shutterfly.com/calendar>
2. Top Right Hand Corner click on "Options" and "Subscribe to calendar"




3. Pop Up will appear. Choose the best way to subscribe based on your current email platform.
 - Example – If you have a "@gmail.com" account you can use Google Calendar. Use this link (<https://gwrranhdistrict.shutterfly.com/calendar#>) to automatically import your Share site calendar into your Google calendar to subscribe.
